Guidelines for Authors

Water experts, academics, policy makers, professionals, private and public sector practitioners, university students and civil society stakeholders from various disciplines and perspectives are welcomed to submit abstracts online to the Taihu International Conference on Water Management (InConTaihu) to share your work and experiences. This document is meant to guide authors who are interested in submitting their work for presentation at the conference.

All submitted papers to InConTaihu will be processed in these steps:

1. Authors submit abstract of their work online for review;
2. Members of the Academic Committee review the submitted abstract and decide whether it's accepted or not, and authors are notified of the decision;
3. Authors submit full paper of their accepted work online for review;
4. Members of the Academic Committee review the submitted full paper and decide whether it's accepted or not, and authors are notified of the decision;
5. Authors present their work at InConTaihu in their preferred way.

For preparation of abstracts, authors should:

1. focus on the theme and topics of the conference;
2. use a clear structure that covers the background, purpose, methods, results, limitations, and conclusions/implications of the reported work;
3. write in the English language;
4. limit the length of the abstract to less than 800 words;
5. exclude graphs, charts, diagrams, images, references, or citations;
6. disclose any potential conflicts of interest related to the abstract content;
7. list all contributing authors with their affiliations;
8. submit no more than two (2) abstracts for each author.
